GO-AHEAD EXPANDS IN SINGAPORE WITH NEW CONTRACT FOR TAMPINES BUS PACKAGE

Singapore, 19 September 2025 – Go-Ahead Group has been awarded the Tampines Bus Package by Singapore's Land Transport Authority (LTA), nearly doubling its presence in the region.

From mid-2026, Go-Ahead Singapore will operate 27 bus routes from the new multi-storey East Coast Bus Depot on an initial five-year contract, with the option for an extension of up to five years. Services will run on a fleet of around 400 buses, which includes over 250 electric buses, furthering Go-Ahead's commitment to sustainable transport.

This milestone builds on Go-Ahead Singapore's partnership with the LTA over the past decade, since it began operating from Loyang Bus Depot in 2016. Recognised recently as one of Singapore's Best Employers 2025 by The Straits Times and Statista, Go-Ahead Singapore will expand its team to around 2,000 colleagues.

With this contract, the company will operate over 800 buses across the island, including more than 270 electric buses, supporting Singapore's transition towards a greener and more inclusive public transport system.

Leveraging its global expertise, Go-Ahead Singapore will bring in international best practices in electric bus operations to enhance service reliability, operational efficiency, and sustainability. Drawing from its experience across multiple markets, the company will setup a Satellite Centre of Excellence in Singapore to build expertise in electric bus operations and maintenance for the industry. It will integrate artificial intelligence (AI) technologies into operations and maintenance to improve overall safety, energy efficiency, and operational excellence.
